





# **Configuring your Windows 2003 SMTP Server to work with infoRouter**


Using the local SMTP server to send  
email messages from infoRouter



Right click on the **My Computer** icon and the select **“Manage”** menu to launch the Management Console



In the Management Console, Navigate to the “**Default SMTP Virtual Server**” node and right mouse click on it. Select the **Properties** menu.




Switch to the **Access** tab.






The **Local host** is now granted rights to relay messages.
